



PROCLAMATION

Whereas, the enrolled agent profession dates back to 1884 when, after questionable claims had been made for Civil War losses, Congress acted to regulate persons who represented citizens in their dealings with the U.S. Department of the Treasury; and

Whereas, since then, these enrolled agents, licensed by the U.S. Department of the Treasury and authorized to be agents for taxpayers wherever the Internal Revenue Service has a presence, have been important advocates for Texas taxpayers; and

Whereas, individuals assist taxpayers with issues from the annual compliance filing of their tax returns to more complex issues of audits, liens, levies, appeals and collections; and

Whereas, in Texas, more than 3,100 enrolled agents assist more than 2.5 million taxpayers every year.

Now, Therefore, I, Alvaro A. Arreola, Mayor of the City of Del Rio, Texas do hereby proclaim February 2025.

“Enrolled Agents Month”

At this time, I encourage all Texans to learn more about the enrolled agents and the work they do to help taxpayers navigate the complexities and intricacies of taxation issues.
